ORDINANCE NO. 1998-1

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE VILLAGE OF POTTER REGARDING THE COLLECTION OF UTILITY/ELECTRIC/WATER/SEWERAGE CHARGES

The Village Board for the Village of Potter, do ordain as follows:

Section 1.01 Collection of Utility/Electric/Water/Sewerage Charges

SECTION 1:

- (a) It is hereby declared a rule of the Village of Potter, that delinquent charges for utilities, electricity, water and/or sewerage shall be imposed as a special charge against the property served, pursuant to Section 66.60 (16), Wisconsin Statutes, which statute is hereby incorporated herein by reference. Such rule, however, shall not preclude collection of such charges by any other means allowed by law.
- (b) Prior to imposing such charges as a special charge against the property served, notice of the delinquent bill or bills shall be sent to both the customer and the property owner advising both that if the bill or bills are not paid within thirty (30) days of the date of the notice, the bill will be placed on the tax roll as a delinquent tax for collection. If the bill or bills are not so paid, then it shall be so placed on the tax roll pursuant to said Statute (Section 66.60 (16) (b)).

<u>SECTION 2:</u> Effective date. This ordinance shall take effect upon passage and publication in accordance of law.

Ordinance No. <u>1998-1</u> was introduced and its adoption moved by Board Member <u>Gene Loose</u> and seconded by Board Member <u>Donald G. Duchow</u>. Upon a roll call of votes, thereon, the results were as follows:
