

Village of Potter, Calumet County  
Recycling Compliance Ordinance  
Ordinance 2006-6

The Village of Potter Board is responsible for enforcing the Village of Potter's recycling ordinance. The Village of Potter's board members shall follow the guidelines identified in this Compliance Assurance Plan in response to issues associated with recycling and solid waste. This plan is intended to meet the requirements of s. NR 544.04 (9g), Wis. Adm. Code as well as Village of Potter's Recycling Ordinance #1994-12.

**Problem:** Property within the Village of Potter found to have no methods of recycling in place.

**Compliance Strategy:**

1<sup>st</sup> Response – The Village recycling coordinator shall send a letter to property owner reminding them of the requirement to comply with local recycling ordinances. Other educational materials will be provided as needed.

2<sup>nd</sup> Response – The Village recycling coordinator shall send a letter to that property owner giving them thirty (30) days to comply with local recycling ordinances. A copy of the letter shall be kept on file by the Village Clerk.

**Penalites** – If, after thirty (30) days has passed, the Village recycling coordinator finds the said property to be in violation of Recycling Ordinance #1994-12, the property owner shall be required to forfeit no less than \$50 and no more than \$100, together with costs of prosecution for the first offense and not less than \$100 nor more than \$200, plus court costs, for each subsequent offense within the calendar year.

The Village of Potter, in compliance with Ordinance #1994-12 regarding Regulation of Establishing a Recycling Program within the Village of Potter, is giving you written notice that the said ordinance must be adhered to. A copy of this ordinance as well as current recycling protocol for Calumet County is available for viewing through any Village of Potter Board member, the Village of Potter Clerk, or the County Courthouse.

**Penalties.** If after thirty (30) days of written notification, the Village of Potter recycling coordinator finds the said property to continue to be in violation of Ordinance 1994-12, the property owner shall forfeit not less than \$50 nor more than \$100, together with the cost of prosecution for the first offense and not less than \$100 nor more than \$200, plus court costs, for each subsequent offense within the calendar year.
